### Specifications

- The Magic Mullum Photography Competition is open to local photographers whose work highlights the magical experience of Mullumbimby. Photographs must be submitted in the following categories:
  - **streetscapes / landscapes**
  - **creative / arty**
  - **local characters**
- Entries are limited to three (3) per person and must be submitted by residents of Mullumbimby only.
- Photography must be original work and taken within the previous 12 months.
- Photography must be submitted in digital format as a JPEG file with a minimum size of 500kB, a maximum size of 5MB and of a minimum resolution of 300dpi.
- Photography must be A4 or 8 x 10 inch in size and may be black and white or colour.

## **Entry**

6. Each entry must be accompanied by an entry form (FORM A1), release form (if applicable) and the applicable entry fee.
7. All images of minors (18 years of under) must be accompanied by a model release form (on back of entry form), which must be signed by the parent or guardian of the model.
8. All children 12 years and under must have a parent or guardian sign their entry form, consenting to the child's participation in the competition.
9. Entry fees are non-refundable and are as follows:
  - Youth entry (18 years old and under): \$10
  - Adult entry (19 years old and over): \$15
10. Payment may be made by cash, cheque or money order. Cheque or money order must be made payable to Mullumbimby Chamber of Commerce. Credit card payments will not be accepted.
11. Entries can be submitted: online at [www.mullumbimby.org.au/magic](http://www.mullumbimby.org.au/magic)
12. Entries can be delivered: during business hours to Mullumbimby Newsagency, corner of Burringbar and Stuart Street, Mullumbimby NSW 2482.
13. Entries can be posted: Magic Mullum Photography Competition C/O Mullumbimby Chamber of Commerce, PO Box 1083, Mullumbimby NSW 2482.
14. Entries must be received by Mullumbimby Chamber of Commerce by close of Entry Stage (see Important Dates above). Entries received post this date won't be accepted.
15. The Committee will appraise entries to ensure applicability to the competition conditions and appropriateness of the photography.
16. Inappropriate material will be rejected and the entry fee forfeited.

## **Exhibition**

17. The Exhibition Stage will last for two months (see Important Dates above).
18. Entries will be put on display at Mullumbimby shops and pop up gallery spaces and must be available for display for the entire period of the exhibition.
19. The Committee will endeavour to display all entries however exhibition is at the discretion of the Committee.
20. In the event that an unprecedented number of entries are received, a selection panel will be formed to view entries and preselect photographs for display in the exhibition.
21. The selection panel's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

## **Judging**

22. An independent judging panel will be nominated by the committee.
23. The Judging Stage will take one day (see Important Dates above).
24. The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
25. Winners will be announced at Biggest Little Banquet event (see Important Dates above).

## **Publicity**

26. The winning photographers must make themselves available for a story and photo with local media organisations.
27. Photograph entries will be held by the Committee and used for promotional purposes online and as prints, postcards, and calendars.
28. The copyright of photographs remains with the photographer. However, the entrant (photographer) authorises and licences the Mullumbimby Chamber of Commerce as set out in the entry form.
